Preparation:

1. The Full-length papers must be prepared in accordance with the manuscript preparation guidelines of the Association's official journal (JISHA). These guidelines are available at: <http://www.jisha.org/contributors.asp>.
2. There must be two components for each full-length paper. The first component is the **first-page file**, comprising of the title of the study, as well as the names and affiliations of all authors. The first-page file must include the name and corresponding address of the first (i.e., the corresponding) author. The second component is the **article file** comprising of the title, and full-length paper with bibliography. No identifying information of authors must be included in the article file. Please visit <http://www.jisha.org/contributors.asp> for more details on the preparation of full-length papers.
3. Avoid the use of bullets in your article file.
4. Ensure that the combined file size does not exceed 1 MB.
