These orations will be given at the time of 42nd ISHA convention, scheduled from 22nd to 24th January 2010 at Bangalore, the Silicon Valley of India. The award comprises of a citation and a trophy.

Nominate your teacher, guide, and fellow-colleague from the field of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology who have offered his/her services for more than 15 years.

Guidelines to nominate for Dr. N. Rathna Oration and Prof. R.K. Oza* oration for the year 2009-10:

- Nominee should be ISHA life member.
- Nominee should be the candidate who has worked in the field of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology for fifteen or more years.
- This work should be done preferably in India.
- The contribution of the work should be in the area of research, manpower development, clinical services, public service at national level, material development and production, public education etc. in the area of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology.
- Candidate should not have rejected any ISHA- award in the past.
- President of ISHA, immediate past president of ISHA and Hon. Gen. Secretary of ISHA will not qualify for the nominations.

Guidelines to nominate for Padmasree Prof. S. Kameswaran Endowment Oration Award for the year 2009-10:

- Nominee should be ISHA life member.
- Nominee should be the candidate who has worked in the field of Audiology for fifteen or more years.

- This work should be done preferably in India.
- The contribution can be in the area of early identification of hearing impaired and / or has spread the message of importance of early intervention in the society.
- Candidate must be applying new technologies and recent advances in the field of Audiology for the upliftment of hearing impaired.
- The contribution can be in the area of:
 - a) Pediatric Audiology
 - b) Clinical Audiology
 - c) Industrial Audiology
 - d) Preventive Audiology
 - e) Geriatric Audiology
 - f) Public Education in Audiology
 - g) Educational Audiology,
 - h) Instrumentation in Audiology.
- Candidate must be promoting the field of Audiology by way of teaching the students of speech language and hearing or ENT or allied professions.
- Candidate must be contributing for the welfare of Audiologists and Speech and Language Pathologists.
- Candidate should not have rejected any ISHA- award in the past.
- President of ISHA, immediate past president of ISHA and Hon. Gen. Secretary of ISHA will not qualify for the nominations.
