

Places to visit in & around Patna



A building in the shape of a beehive, Golghar originally served the purpose of a storehouse. It was built in 1786 by Captain John Garstin and provides a panoramic view of the entire city along with the River Ganga.



Agam Kuan has many legends associated with it. With a depth of 105 ft and perimeter of over 20 feet, the well was constructed by Ashoka to torture people.



Mahavir Mandir is dedicated to *Hanuman*. It is believed that this temple was built in the year 1730 AD. The temple underwent modifications in the years 1983 and 1985.



Nalanda ranks amongst the first few residential universities in the world. It was established in 5th century AD and it had scholars and students visiting from various parts of the world.



Bodhi Tree is a religious site and place as it is the place where Gautama Buddha is said to have obtained Enlightenment under Bodhi Tree. It is also famous for the famous Vishnupad Mandir.
