Guidelines for Padmashree Kameswaran Endowment Oration

Eligibility

A speech and hearing professional who is

- a life members of ISHA,
- who has worked in the field of audiology for 15 or more years, preferably in India,
- who has contributed significantly in the area of early identification of hearing impairment and / or has spread the message of importance of early intervention in the society,
- who has significantly contributed in applying new technologies and recent advances in the field of Audiology for the upliftment of individuals with hearing impairment,
- who has made significant contribution to research and manpower development programs in the field of Audiology,
- who has contributed significantly to the welfare of audiologists and speech-language pathologists, and
- who has maintained high ethical standards throughout his/her professional career will be eligible to be considered for this award

Eligibility

A speech and hearing professional who is

- a life members of ISHA,
- who has worked in the field of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for 15 or more years, preferably in India,
