Financial assistance from ISHA for ISHA Life members & Student members

1. ISHA encourages life and student members who are presenting papers at ISHACON or other conferences, whether held within or outside India, to apply for sponsorship.

2. Before the Conference:

- a. Send an email to the secretary requesting sponsorship at least one to two months in advance.
- b. Attach proof of life or student membership, such as an e-certificate.
- c. Attach proof of acceptance, such as an email or letter from the conference organizer confirming your paper's acceptance.
- 3. Notification of Approval or Rejection from the Secretary:
 - a. The life or student member will receive an email from the ISHA secretary informing them of the approval or rejection of their request. This email will include the relevant terms and conditions.

4. After the conference

- a. Submit a report upon return, including copies of the flight tickets, the acceptance letter, and the presentation certificate that indicates you were the presenting author.
- b. Acknowledge the support provided by ISHA in your presentation at the conference.
- c. Submit the research article you presented at the conference for publication in JISHA (www.jisha.org). The manuscript will undergo the regular review process like other submissions to JISHA.
- d. The grant amount will be released only after the article is published in JISHA.
- 5. Once the article is published in JISHA, the applicant should notify the secretary by sending an email and also provide their account details.
