Dr. Natesh Rathna was one of the founding life members (L11030001) of ISHA and served on its Executive Committee in various capacity including the President of ISHA. He was and will be widely regarded as the "Teacher of Teachers" in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology. 





CONNECT: A Private Practitioners Unity Meet and a skill training workshop will be organized by Indian Speech-Language & Hearing Association

ISHA introduces for the first time a skilled based workshop and physical meet of the private practitioners named **CONNECT**. 

This document aims to establish uniform nomenclature and terminologies for speechlanguage pathologists and audiologists in India, enhancing consistency in their clinical practices.

This can be used by ISHA members as a training module on vocal hygiene for school teachers. National Conference on 'Mainstreaming Rehabilitation in Healthcare system in India'







Dr. Rout is an exceptional academician, clinician and an ardent advocate for persons with disabilities. His personality, confidence and enthusiasm are an inspiration to all. He consistently demonstrates through his actions that innovation, astute clinical skills and willingness to learn continuously are a hallmark of a successful professional career. Dr. Nachiketa's values predict a bright future for the field of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology.

Dr. Nachiketa Rout is an alumnus of AYINISHD and received his Ph.D. from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, He has a vast pan-India experience and has worked as a clinician, academician, teacher & administrator at Mumbai, Lucknow, Bhopal, Kolkata, Dehradun & Chennai. His pan India experience makes him well-rounded.

He rose the ranks and has been serving as Director, National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan), Chennai and served as Director, National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities, Dehradun. In sync with the digital times, he has a Youtube channel where he has 3840 subscribers and has uploaded 290 videos. These videos Mave information both for the public and professionals alike. His videos are extremely engaging and create advocacy for the profession.

A keen researcher, he has contributed to four books which have been included as textbooks in the RCI Approved Syllabus for BASLP Course. 

Mr. Mandayam Aji Srikanth/aka Srikanth earned his Bachelor degree from the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, Mysuru. His passion for accuracy and excellence in clinical work enabled him to build up his career. His achievement is a lot more noteworthy because it is posited in a predominantly tribal area. If such yeomanry has been shown to be possible in the most neglected, unreached and deprived populations, success could have come only with a great deal of sacrifice, forethought and hope. He stands out as a beacon of hope, as a model for potential and an example of how service to society can still be made sustainable despite financial obstacles. His persistence for four decades set the path for the next generation to follow.

He began his practice in Vishakapatnam, in 1982 at a time when knowledge about Audiologists was minimal to zero. Vishakapatnam then had a school for children with hearing impairment. He began working in the Omkar and Lions School for the Deaf as Principal and was subsequently deputed to the Government E.N.T. Hospital, Visakhapatnam and Government General Hospital, Kakinada as Audiologist. He retired as Audiologist in the Hearing Aid Centre, A.P. Differently Abled and Senior Citizens Assistance Corporation, Andhra Pradesh. From his work in Lawsons Bay, he never looked back, building a name for himself in Vizag and later in the speech and hearing world.

He received training in Cochlear Implant in Melbourne and continues to update his knowledge. He trains many audiologists in the field some of who are posted as interns. His towering reputation for accurate diagnosis and appropriate therapy enabled his interaction with EMT surgeons and other medical practitioners. This partnership enabled the creation of a sustainable cochlear implant program, that continues to grow. 
Indian Speech and Hearing Association, Maharashtra Branch conducted the following activities:

Mysuru


- MyISHA committed to contributing Rs. 7,00,000/towards the construction of the new ISHA office building.






